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 <p><b>Every PNR Tells a Story (hotspot graphics of RH and RHI)</b> Learners will select the different parts of a PNR history image to learn more about each segment.</p> <p><b>Review the history codes</b> Button with a direct link to <a href="#">HT 10046 Retrieving and Reading PNR flight history</a> to review the list of PNR history codes, followed by a matching exercise (SME to provide favorites to use).</p>	
<p><b>The What and When about PNR Changes (15 minutes)</b> Learners will review how to interpret when and who made changes to a PNR.</p> <p><b>Every PNR History Tells a Story of Change</b> A video telling a story (scenario) around the origination and how to identify changes that occurred within a PNR history. As the graphical characters emulate the story, the PNR history reveals the details along the way (reimagined from Actions Performed in the PNR). To accomplish this, I will need the SME to provide a PNR history with as many actions as possible in the exercise.</p> <p><b>Action and Change Codes</b> This will be 3 tabs displaying the RH and RHI codes. <p>Learners sort the codes into categories of HE, RH, and RHI (Idea: humanize the codes related to what they represent in plain language to help secure the connection).</p> <p><b>Match that change</b> Learners will match change codes with their interpretations.</p> <p><b>Source Material:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● GNH Amadeus PNR History 2283 FG EN</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Who made that PNR change? (10 minutes)</b> Learners identify the details about where, when, and by whom a change occurred to a PNR history.</p> <p><b>Every PNR Tells a Story...About Change Sources</b> The traveler story continues with an agent identifying important details that led the PNR down the path of changes, covering the different sources of change:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Automation (website or automated process).</li> <li>● Automated major schedule change process.</li> <li>● Cornerstone (minor 3rd party schedule change processor).</li> <li>● CAT agent.</li> <li>● Frontline agent.</li> </ul> <p><b>Amadeus Received field by action or tool</b> This bulleted list will give a summary of the specific codes to recognize as listed on page 22 of the FG.</p>	<p><b>Format:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Every PNR Tells a Story...About Change Sources</b> Video: animated</li> <li>● <b>Amadeus Received field by action or tool</b> Rise bulleted list</li> </ul>
<p>(3 hrs, 15 minutes) Section 3 – Try It! Workshop</p> <p>COs: (1-4)</p>	
<p><b>Ten Cent Tour Demonstration (30 minutes)</b> In this show and share activity, the facilitator opens up a detailed PNR History from Amadeus and provides a tour of the history, reviewing the points learned in the self-paced training, taking the opportunity to enhance or reinforce important details.</p> <p><b>Debrief questions: (CO 1-4)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● CO2 Does the live PNR history differ from what you saw in your training?</li> </ul>	<p><b>Format:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Ten Cent Tour:</b> Screen share in Amadeus PNR History</li> </ul>

<p><b>Find the Amadeus Action Code Contest (30 minutes)</b></p> <p>Learners race to find action codes in the PNR history using the Amadeus help pages. <p><b>Amadeus Action Codes Activity (30 minutes)</b></p> <p>Learners will utilize the action codes to determine the actions within a PNR. <p><b>Who Did It? (30 minutes)</b></p> <p>In this contest, learners will determine where to obtain information to identify who performed the changes to a PNR. <p>(30 minutes) Section 4 – Master It! Wrap-Up and Assessment COs:1-4</p>	
<p><b><u>Description of Content</u></b></p> <p><i>In the Master It! section, learners will check their understanding of the traveler’s journey from booking a flight to arriving at their destination by completing a comprehensive assessment.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Review:</b> Scenario exercise where different actions and changes are summarized and learners identify where on the PNR history they are presented.</li> <li>● <b>Proficiency Assessment:</b> 10-question assessment to assess learner understanding of course content.</li> <li>● <b>Course Wrap-Up:</b> End-of-course reminders to prompt learners to verify they’ve completed all portions of the course prior to exiting.
